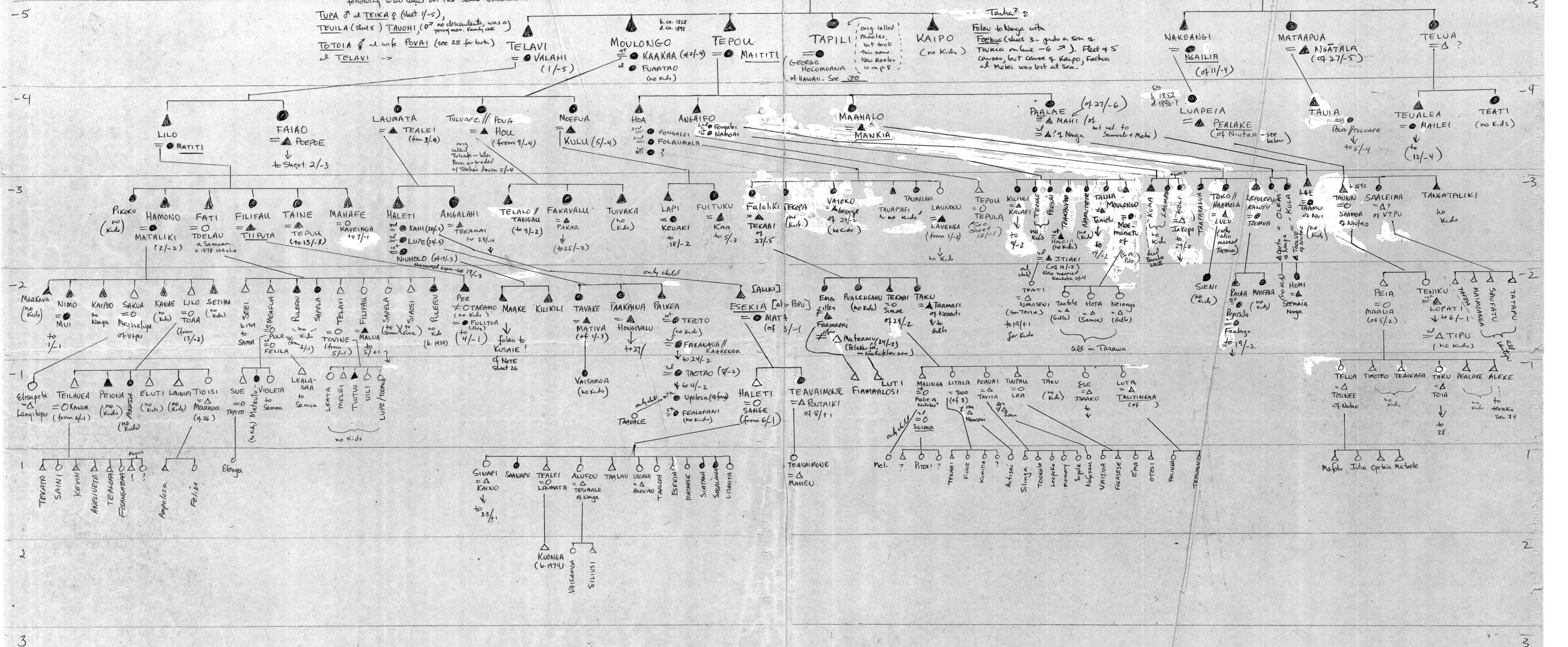


Peia (Paitela + Tuukia, of Ngelua)

These 3 brothers were all "TOA" (warriors). Mouloungo was the leader (not Ahk. to) of Naniwa at coming of church in 1872 - and when TURNER visited in 1874 he was listed as the "real ruler" [but name was given as MOUWOU see sheet 3]

BLACKBIRDING
NOTE on TELAVI - oldest bro, but disappeared on a blackbirding ship ca. 1861-63 - thus Mouloungo took over. Taulia lists the following who went on the same blackbirds:



To TEFOLAHA, TEPOU's Genealogy MOULONGO
