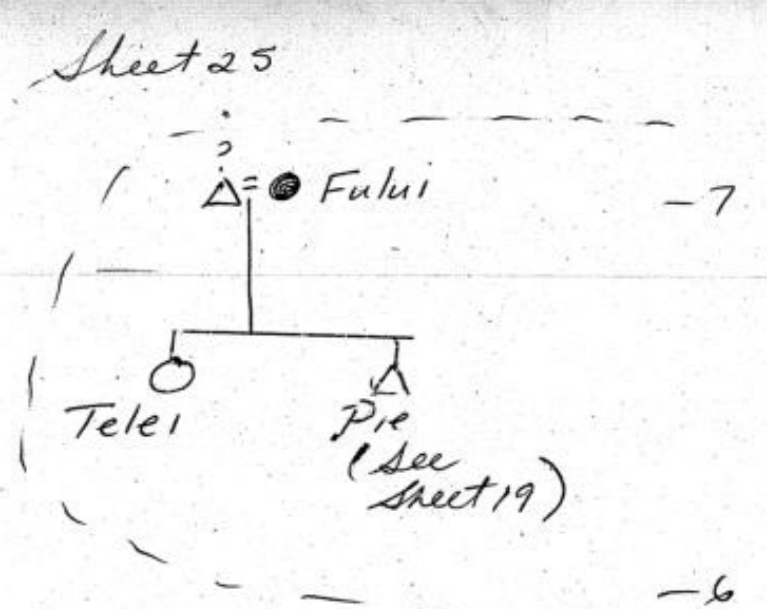

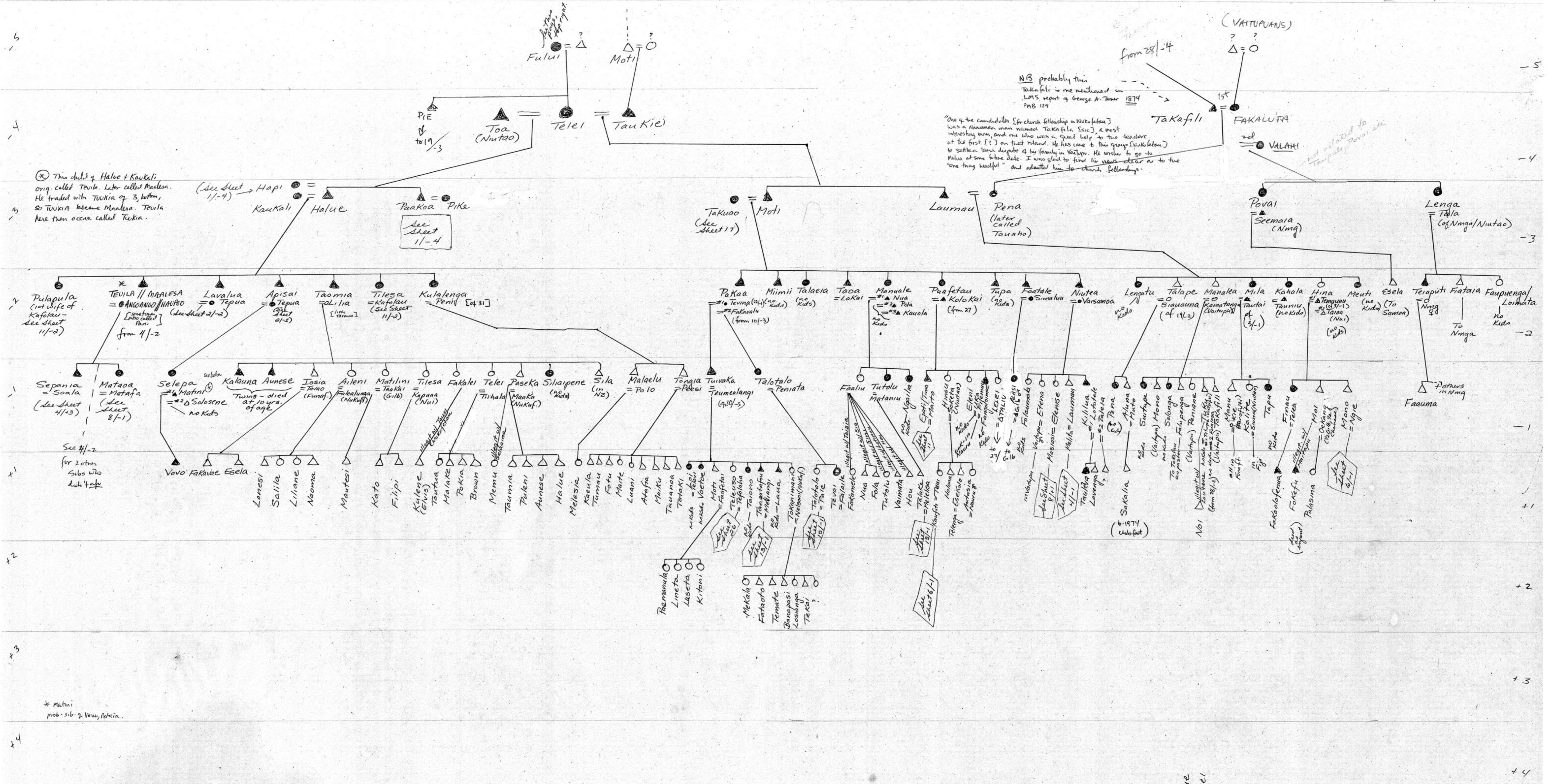

here from occs. called TUKIA.

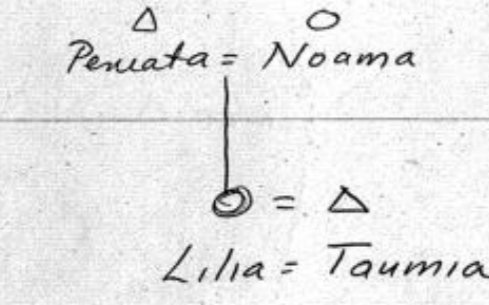
NB probably this

"One of the candidates [for church fellowship in Nukunono] was a Naamua man named Takafuli. He was a most interesting man, and one who was a great help to the leaders at the first [?] on that island. He has come to this group [Nukunono] to settle. Some dispute of his family in Vaitupu. He wishes to go to Nukunono at some future date. I was glad to find he was clear as to the "one thing beautiful" and admitted him to church fellowship."

Taulaha

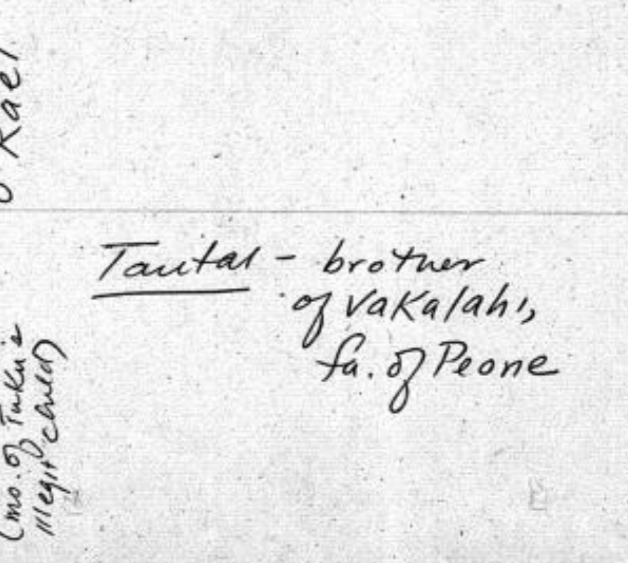


Tevina = related to Petava
