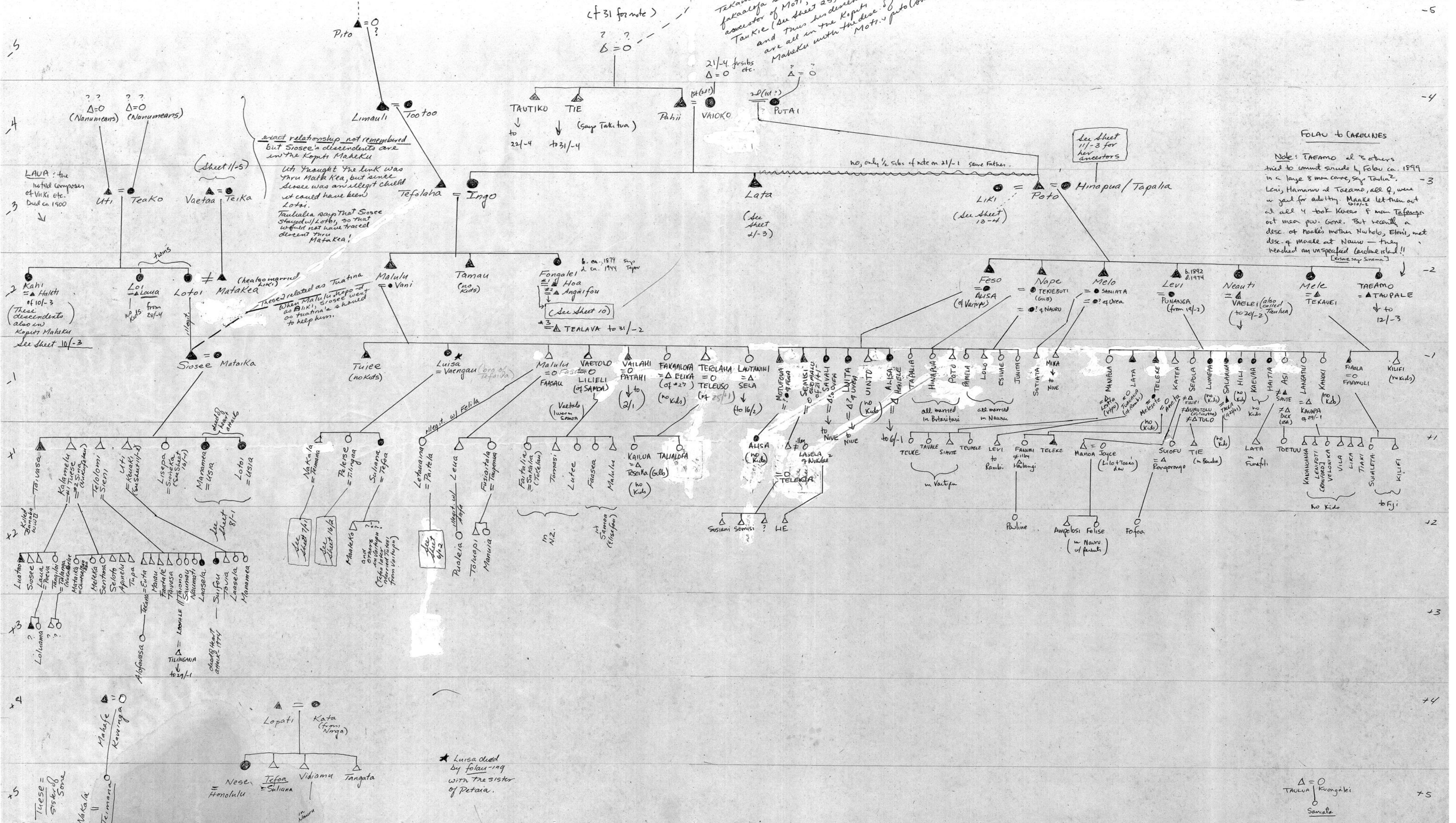

To Loveaga son of Tefolaha

This line goes to Te Kamata, who came here from Bevu at same time Ta, ta, & Teu, ta died. He married an unknown Nanyuan woman and eventually descended to Ingo, Lata & Poto. Te Kamata was adopted as a fakaalofa stranger by an ancestor of Moti, the father of Taukie (see sheet 25) and thus his descendants are all in the Kopiti & Matieku with the desc. of Moti & Poto (sheet 25)



exact relationship not remembered but Siosee's descendants are in the Kopiti Matieku

Uti thought the link was thru Mata Kea, but since Siosee was an illegit child it could have been Lotai. Taulialia says that Siosee stayed w/ Lotai, so that would not have traced descent thru Mata Kea!

These related as Tuatina when Malulu shipped out as a kid, Siosee went to Tuatina's house to help him.

no, only 1/2 sib of note on 21/1 same father.

Note: TAEAMO & others tried to unload Siosee by folau ca. 1899 in a large 8 man canoe, say Taulia, Loni, Hamanu al Taeamo, etc. & were in jail for adultery. Maake let them out & all 4 took Kueas & men Tefolaha out near pw. Gona. But recently a desc. of Maake's mother Nuholo, Eleri, met desc. of Maake at Nauru - they reached an unspecified Caroline island!! [Kueas say Siosee]

LAVA: the noted composer of Viki etc. Died ca 1900
