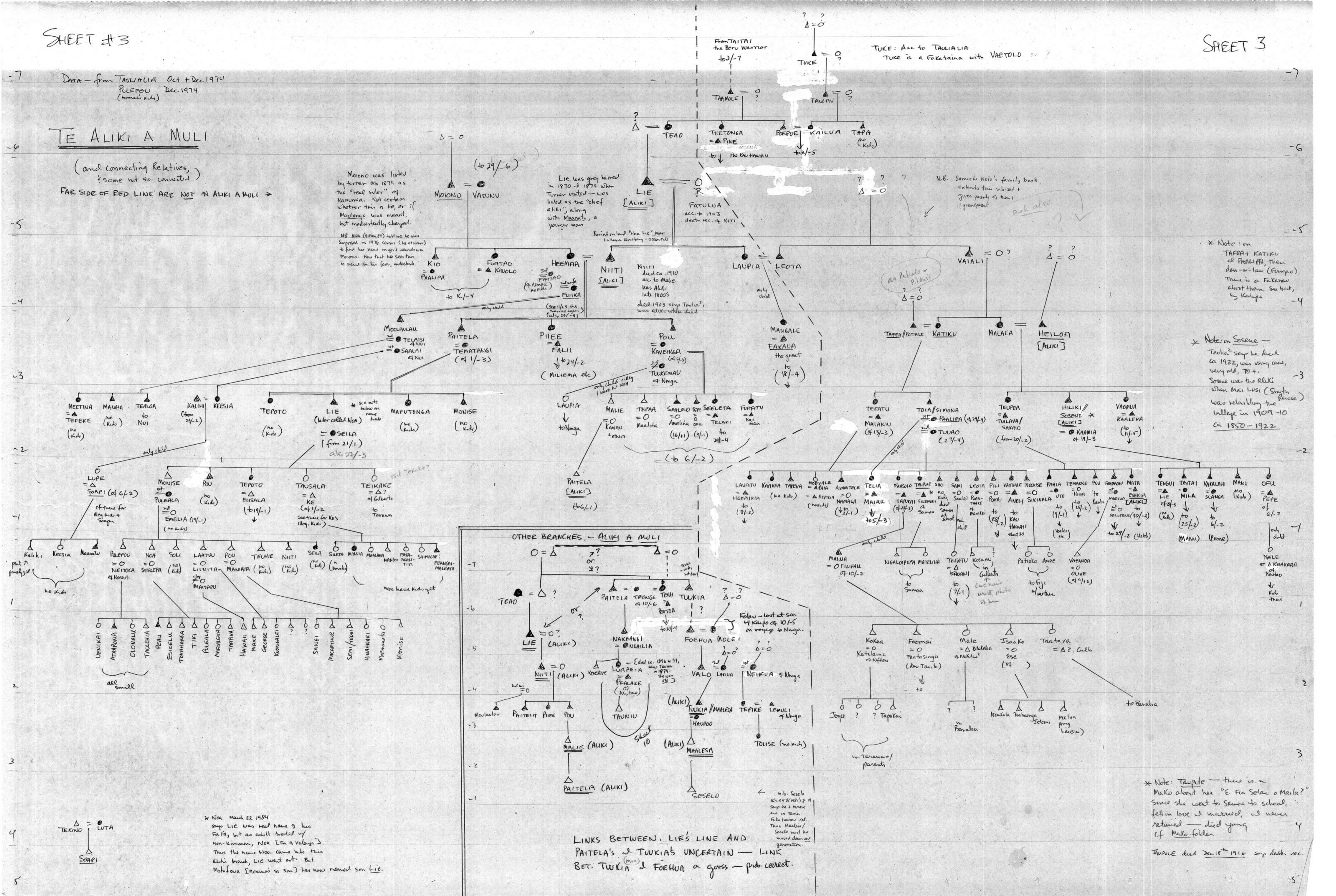

Mioino was listed by Turner in 1874 as the "real ruler" of Nantanea. Not certain whether this is he, or if Moulougo was meant, but inadvertently changed.

N.B. Non (sp. 1874) told me he was surprised in 1978 census (he at home) to find his name in 1874 records was Mioino. Now that has been in name in his form, unaltered.

Lie was grey haired in 1970 & 1974 when Turner visited - was listed as the "chief aliki" along with Mearatu, a younger man.

TAKE: Acc to TAULALIA
TAKE is a FAKATAINA with VAETOLO



* Note: on TAPEA KATIKU or PAALIPA, then dau-in-law (Fingau). This is a FAKATAINA about them. See book by Kaulapa

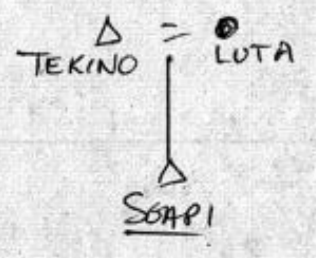
* Note: on Sosen - Taula says he died ca 1922, was using cane, very old, 70+. Sosen was the aliki when Misi Lusi (Smith Reuse) was rebuilding the village in 1909-10 ca 1850-1922

OTHER BRANCHES - ALIKI A MULI

LINKS BETWEEN LIE'S LINE AND PAITELA'S & TUUKIA'S UNCERTAIN - LINK BET. TUUKIA & FOEHUA a guess - prob correct.

* Note: Taula - there is a Mako about her "E Fia Selau o Maila?" Since she went to Samoa to school, fell in love & married, & never returned - died young of Mako fever.

* Noa Maud 22 1984 says LIC was real name of his father, but as adult traveled w/ non-Kimmam, Noa [Fa a Velava]. Thus the name Noa came into this aliki branch, LIC went out. But Moulougo [Mouiso at sm] has now named son LIE.



n.b. Sesele is a 1930 census & a 1974 census he is Mause and in Tama - Faka Tama set. Thus Mause/Sesele must be merged down at generation.

FUPELE died Dec 18 1916 says death rec.
